PERSONAL PROTECTION

OUTSIDE THE HOME

PREREQUISITE: YOU MUST BE 21 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, BE LEGALLY QUALIFIED TO OWN A FIREARM AND HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED AN NRA PERSONAL PROTECTION IN THE HOME COURSE. (*ILLINOIS RESIDENTS MUST HAVE A VALID FOID CARD*)

This 14+ hour course introduces students to the knowledge, skills and attitude involved in safely, responsibly and effectively employing a concealed handgun for self-defense. The course includes classroom lecture and live fire exercises.

NOTE: *There is a minimum standard of "Hits-on-Target" required to receive an NRA Certificate for this course.*

HERE'S SOME OF WHAT YOU'LL LEARN:

- The legal aspects of concealed carry and self-defense.
- Safety rules specific to defensive situations outside the home.
- Different concealed carry modes, their benefits and limitations.
- Presentation and firing of the handgun from concealment.
- Shooting and Moving. How to avoid a confrontation.

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING:

A medium caliber handgun and strong side belt holster suitable for concealed carry. (*No small-of-the-back, inside the belt or shoulder holsters*). An extra magazine or speed loader plus the appropriate belt holders. Approximately 300 rounds of ammunition will be required.

Eye and ear protection.

A mature attitude about a serious subject.
