PISTOL INSTRUCTOR COURSE

PREREQUISITE: ATTENDANCE AT AN NRA BASIC PISTOL COURSE. ALL CANDIDATES FOR THE POSITION OF CERTIFIED INSTRUCTOR MUST BE 21 YEARS OLD OR OLDER AND LEGALLY QUALIFIED TO POSSESS A FIREARM.

This 17+ hour course equips the instructor candidate to **TEACH** Basic NRA Courses. If you possess a solid background in firearm safety and shooting skills, are 21 years old, have a FOID card, have a desire to pass on your knowledge to others and are willing to make a commitment to organize and teach Basic NRA Courses, this course is for you.

The course includes classroom lecture, classroom & range exercises and live fire exercises.

HERE'S SOME OF WHAT YOU'LL LEARN:

The NRA 3 step training process. The elements of Total Participant Involvement.
Student evaluation techniques. The characteristics, sources and proper use of training aids and materials.
Teaching principles and teaching methods. Shooter coaching techniques.

A notebook and pen. One .22 caliber handgun. (*.22 ammunition will be provided.*)
