RANGE SAFETY OFFICER COURSE

PREREQUISITE: *STUDENTS MUST BE (1) 21 YEARS OF AGE AND (2) HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED AN NRA BASIC PISTOL OR RIFLE COURSE.*

This 9+ hour course is for experienced shooters who have or want to assume Range Safety Officer Responsibilities. Course content is classroom lecture only. No live fire.

Emergency procedures Directing the Firing Line

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING:

A pen and note pad
Lunch (*There will be a 30 minute lunch period*)
A willingness to learn, a positive attitude and a desire to have an enjoyable experience.

NOTE: *This is not a shooting class. Do not bring guns or ammunition.*
